War In Ukraine/NATO

- According to the MoD, Russian troops have set up fighting positions on the roof of reactor buildings at the occupied Zaporizhzhia nuclear plant - in anticipation for an offensive where Ukraine may try to reclaim the plant.
- Reuters: Russia does not intend to take the path of nuclear escalation in its standoff with the West over Ukraine but others should not test its patience, Russian foreign ministry spokeswoman Maria Zakharova [said](#) on Thursday.

AUKUS

- Australia's defence minister [said](#) on Friday that the government was being “upfront and transparent” about the cost of its AUKUS nuclear submarine programme, after an analysis showed the forecast A\$368 billion cost included a 50% contingency fund.

Test Veterans

- Veterans of the British nuclear tests are being [sought](#) for a £250,000 project to create a documentary with the British Library, and to be taught to A-level students.

Chernobyl
