TAKING BACK OUR RIVERS

Windrush Against Sewage Pollution

Ashley Smith, the founder of WASP – Windrush Against Sewage Pollution – spoke to Faringdon Peace Group about the fight to stop water companies using our rivers as toilets for profit. For too long this practice has gone unnoticed, but now it has been exposed this issue is, according to the Lib Dems, ‘bigger than potholes’!

WASP (<https://www.windrushwasp.org>) is a small campaigning group of volunteers and registered charity with the aim of ending sewage pollution and improving effluent standards to make rivers safe for all life, big and small. They collect and analyse information on water quality and sewage discharges, raise public awareness and engage with councils, water companies and government agencies to identify illegal dumping, bring the water companies to justice and try to bring in legislation to improve the dire state of our rivers. While they concentrate on sewage pollution from treatment works rather than pollution from farms, they have found local farmers very approachable and keen to do what they can to protect rivers.

The packed Meeting House was shocked to hear that only 14% of English rivers meet the standard of ‘good’ ecological status, based on fish populations, water chemistry and water plants. The once beautiful river Wye is virtually dead and our unique chalk streams are under threat.

The Faringdon Brook in Lechlade Road is over the limit for untreated sewage spills and the Ampney Brook near Fairford discharged raw sewage into the River Coln continuously for nearly a month in March. Such discharges are permitted only in emergencies, such as during storms when sewage plants cannot cope with the volume of water, but they have become everyday occurrences.

Ash’s photos of waterways contaminated with sewage, wet wipes, sanitary products etc. were truly disgusting, and very sad considering the beautiful wildlife havens and bathing spots they had once been.

There is no pressure on water companies to make the huge investments necessary to update and enlarge existing water treatment works despite their billions of pounds of profits. Re-nationalising water companies is not the answer according to Ash – we should mutualise them like the original Building Societies, where profits are shared by customers. At present 8% of Thames Water is owned by China, which probably doesn’t care much about the health of our rivers!

Ash explained that every 100 new houses produce 30 tons of sewage a year. WASP is pushing the government to adopt ‘Grampian conditions’ whereby the water companies must sort out wastewater treatment before new homes are inhabited.

Although Thames Water produce their own live maps of spillages (See Thames Water EDM) – often clear evidence of law breaking – on the rare occasions when they are prosecuted, the fines are meaningless compared to the massive profits they make through that law breaking, and yet no-one has gone to prison. Ash claims that the regulator and the government are working more in the water companies’ interests than those of the general public. However, public awareness and outrage is growing, thanks to groups like WASP and programmes such as Paul Whitehouse’s excellent ‘Our Troubled Rivers’ (Available on I-Player) and once the government see it as an election issue – and it’s up to us to make it so – it will need to radically change its water policies.

“THE BIG ONE” EXTINCTION REBELLION OUTSIDE PARLIAMENT 21-23 APRIL

Emma Markham, one of our Quaker Friends attended the Extinction Rebellion protest "The Big One" outside of Parliament in London, which formally received support from over 200 organisations, including CAFOD, Tearfund, NHS workers, the PCS union, Greenpeace, and Quakers, and was attended by over 60,000 people.

Emma writes: "On Friday Quakers gathered at 4pm to march from St James park to Parliament Square and then held a meeting for worship on the lawn for 30 minutes. There was something special about having a meeting for worship outside in the sunshine, a peace descended on the whole area



despite being in central London surrounded by thousands of people, and all that could be heard was a bell ringing and some distant traffic. So many people from different walks of life joined us, and the local meeting house in Westminster opened its doors to us. It was so moving to see Quakers gathering from all over the UK to unite in peacefully calling for justice and action on climate change, which will impact the lives of those least responsible or able to take action and future generations. Our meeting felt like a symbol of hope, to unite and stand in solidarity with so many other people, putting faith into action.

Stockholm International Peace Institute’ annual
report finds UK was region’s biggest spender in
2022 at \$68.5bn.
