

LOCAL DAY OF ACTION ORGANISED BY PALESTINE SOLIDARITY CAMPAIGN

In response to the appalling situation in Gaza, the PSC called for a day of local organisation to demand a ceasefire. Closest to Salisbury was the peace vigil in Southampton. A reasonable crowd gathered despite the weather, listening to several speakers and organisers from the local Palestinian community and others. Chants between speeches included 'Ceasefire Now!' and 'From the river to the sea, Palestine will be free'. There was a lot of anger around the fact that we have been failed yet again by our political leaders, and that neither the Tories or Labour are representing the views of the majority of the British public towards the conflict.

Organisers announced that a coach will be heading up from Southampton to London next Saturday (11th), when it is hoped one million people will turn out to demand that the genocide stops.
